Sea Japan 2026 opens on April 22 at Tokyo Big Sight The largest-ever international exhibition for the next generation of maritime industries

Informa Markets Japan Co., Ltd. will hold the international maritime exhibition "Sea Japan 2026" at Tokyo Big Sight exhibition center from 22-24 April.

Sea Japan, which has been held biennially since 1994 will be the largest ever. For the next edition, we will further expand the size and scope of this exhibition for the next generation of the maritime industry. In addition to "Offshore & Port Tech", an exhibition that has been held in conjunction with the previous show, this year we will hold "Digital Solution Square" for the first time, focusing on productivity improvement, work style reform and new value creation in the digital field.
