## Sea Japan 2024 – Focus on Fuels of the Future

The 15<sup>th</sup> edition of the Sea Japan International Maritime Exhibition and conference will be held at Tokyo Big Sight on 10-12 April 2024. Sea Japan 2024 will feature a new co-located event entitled "Offshore Tech" that will focus on offshore energy and port technologies. This will provide opportunities of not only development new businesses based on maritime technology, but also explore new possibility of introducing technology from other industries that have not traditionally been involved in the maritime industry.
