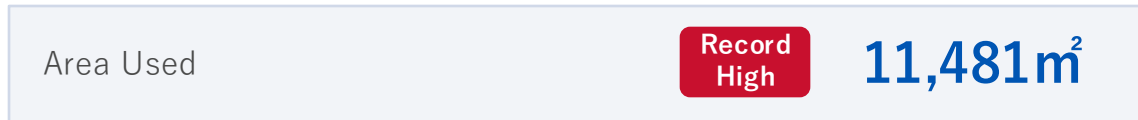

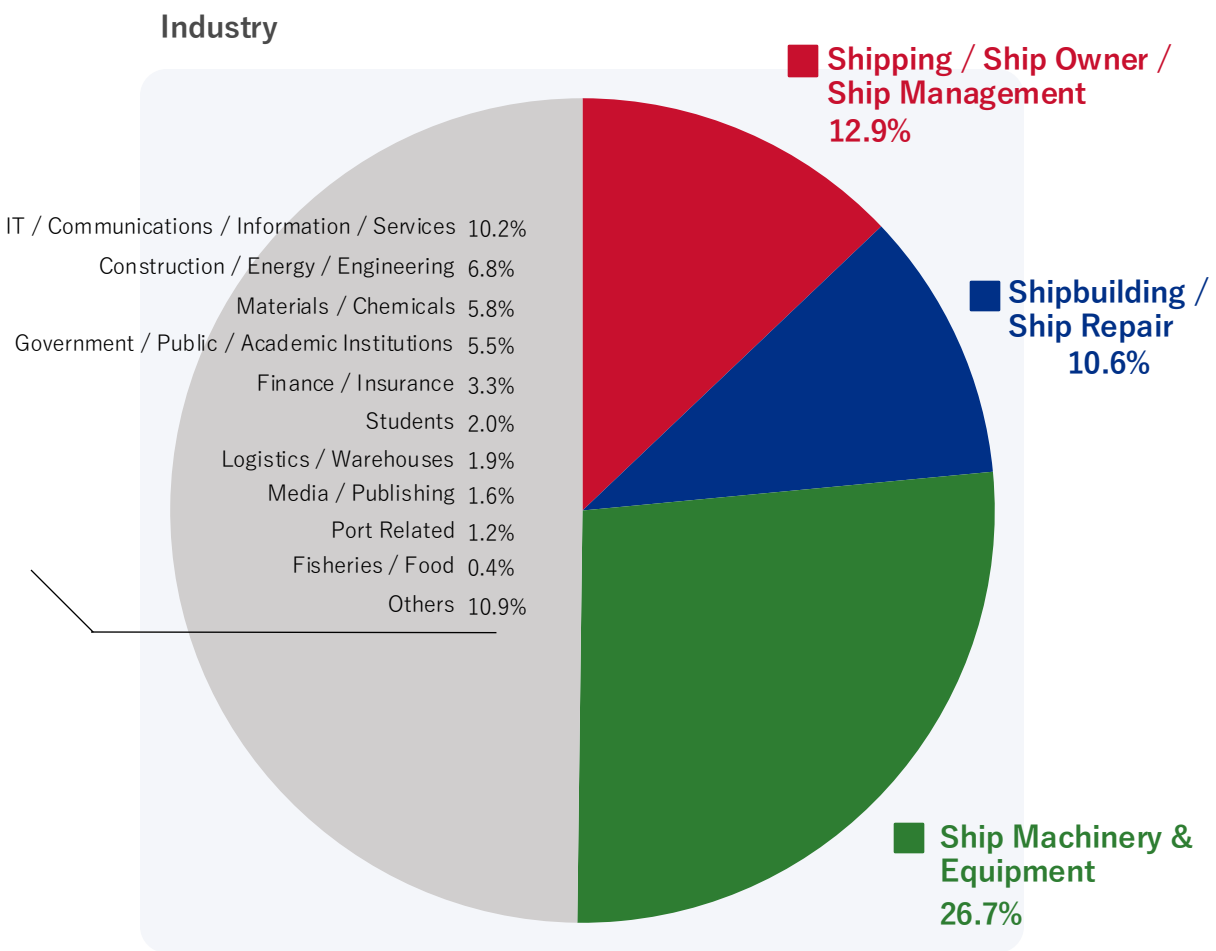

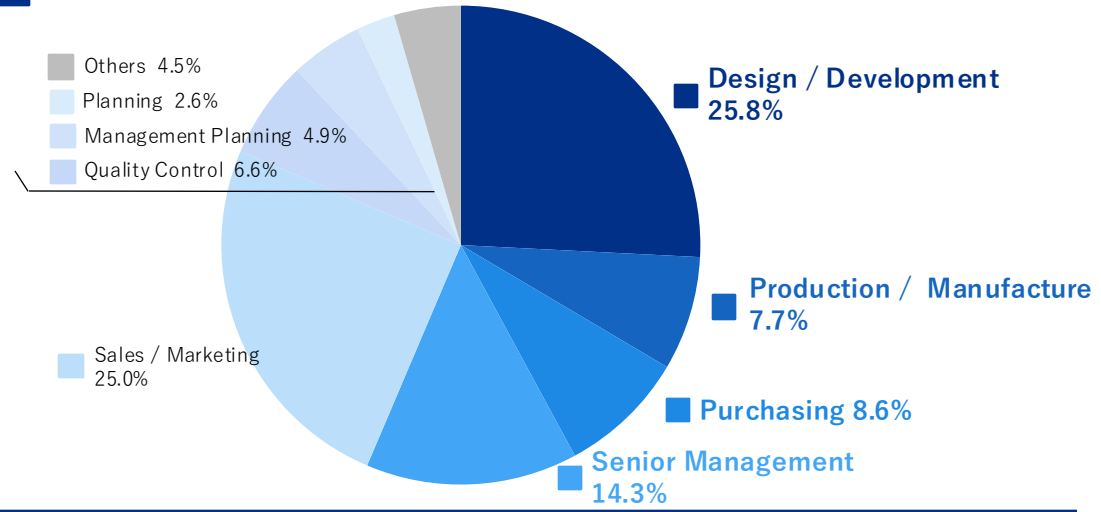

### Shipping Companies, Shipowners & Ship Management — Job Function

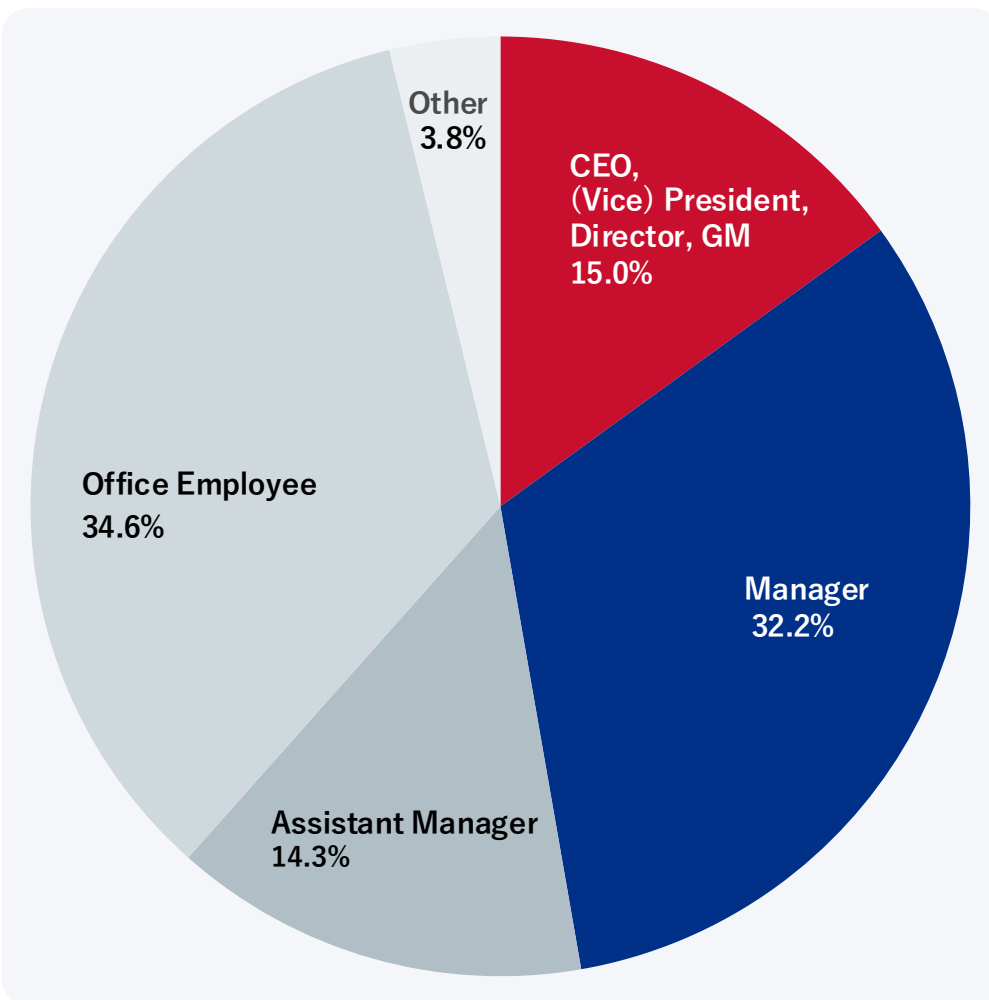


### Shipbuilding & Ship Repair — Job Function

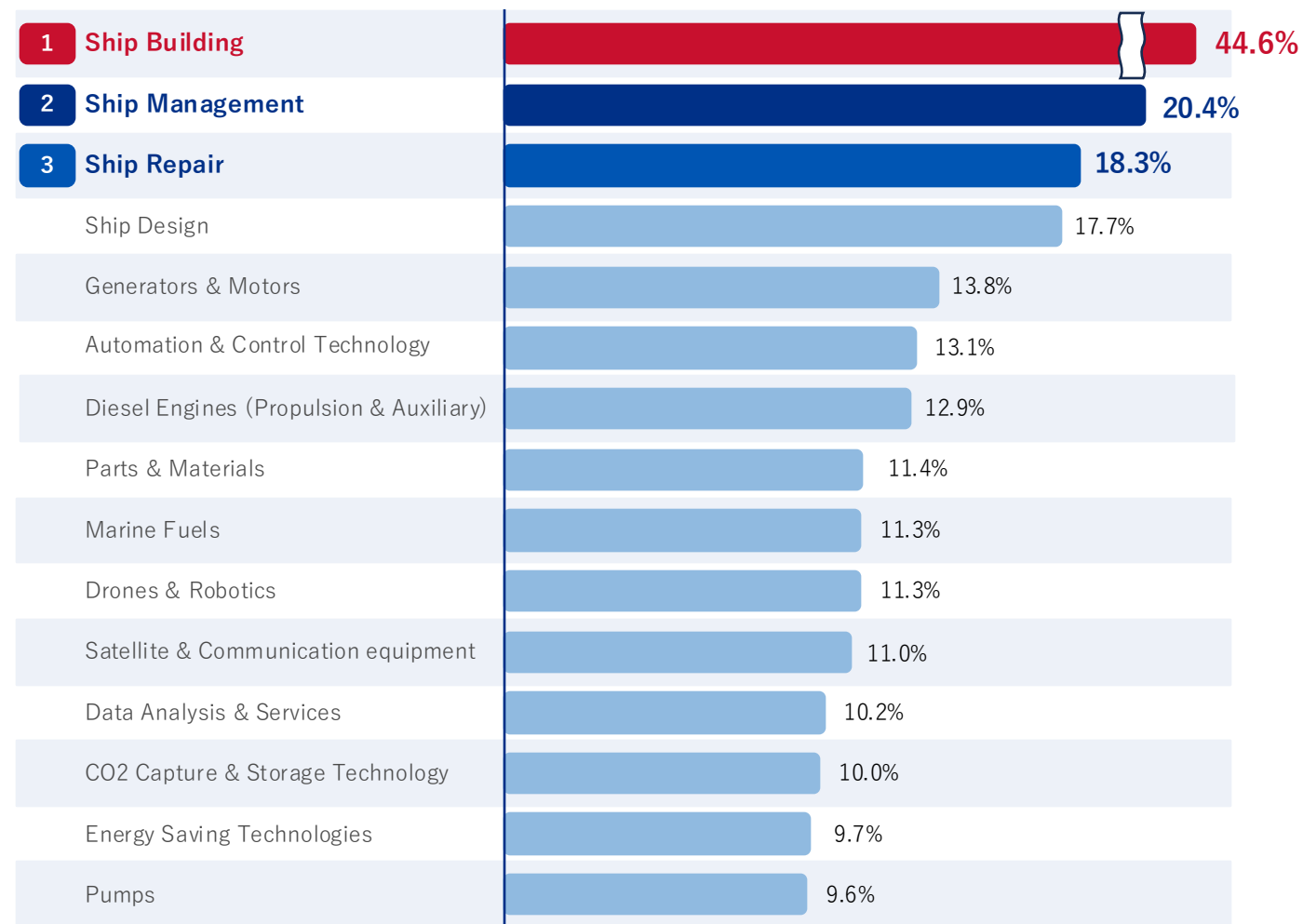

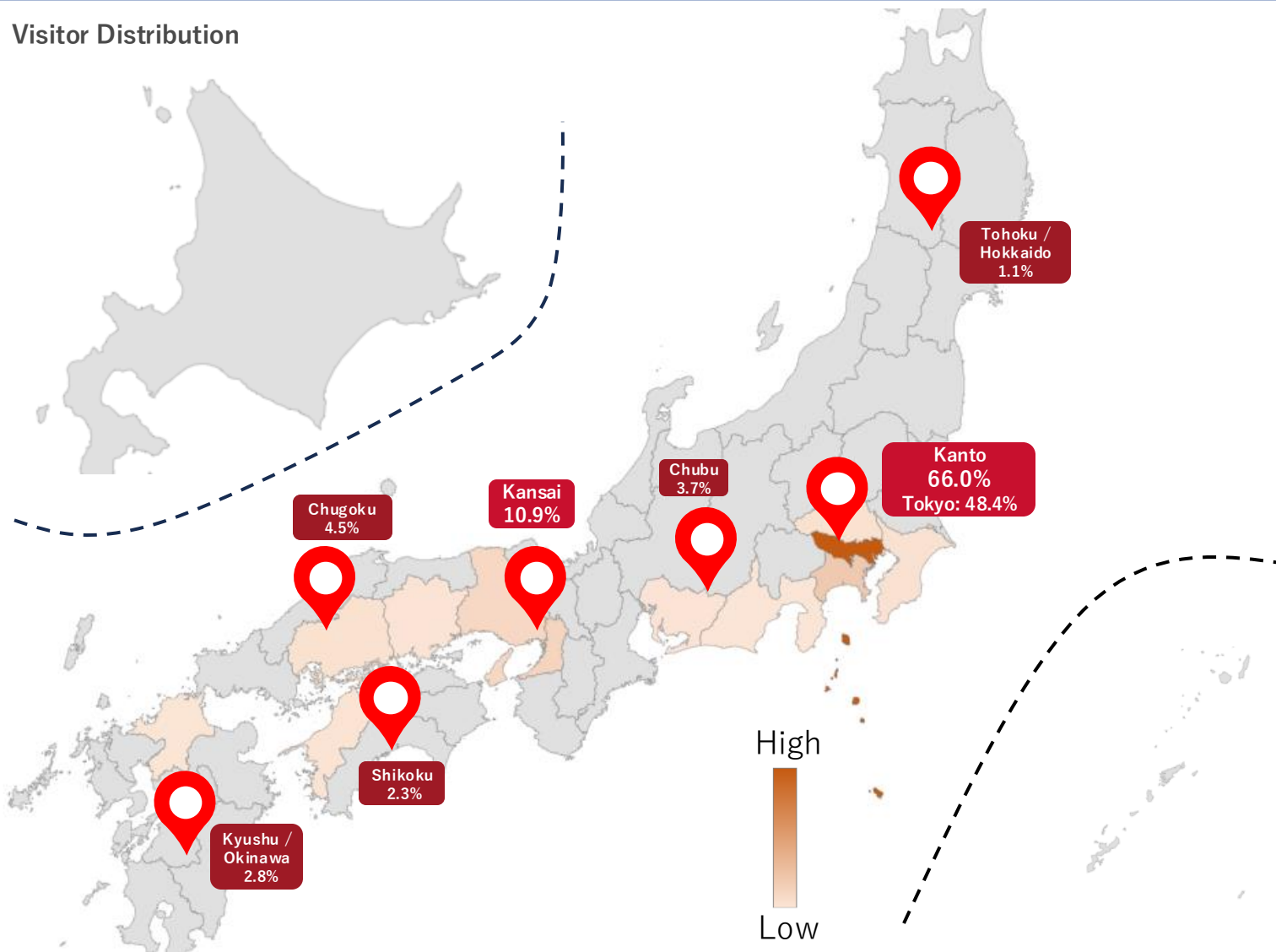

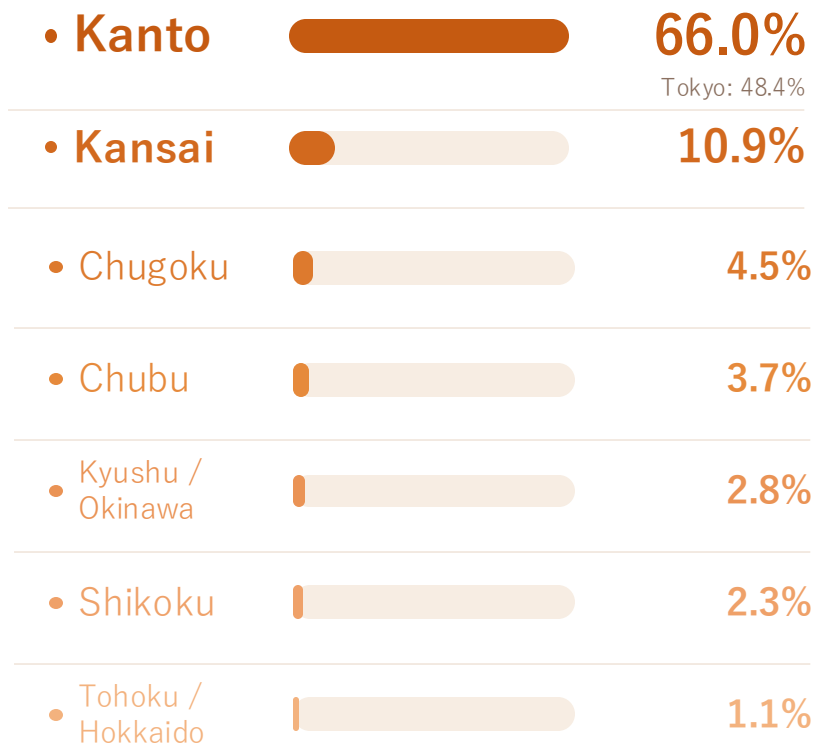

Visitor Distribution



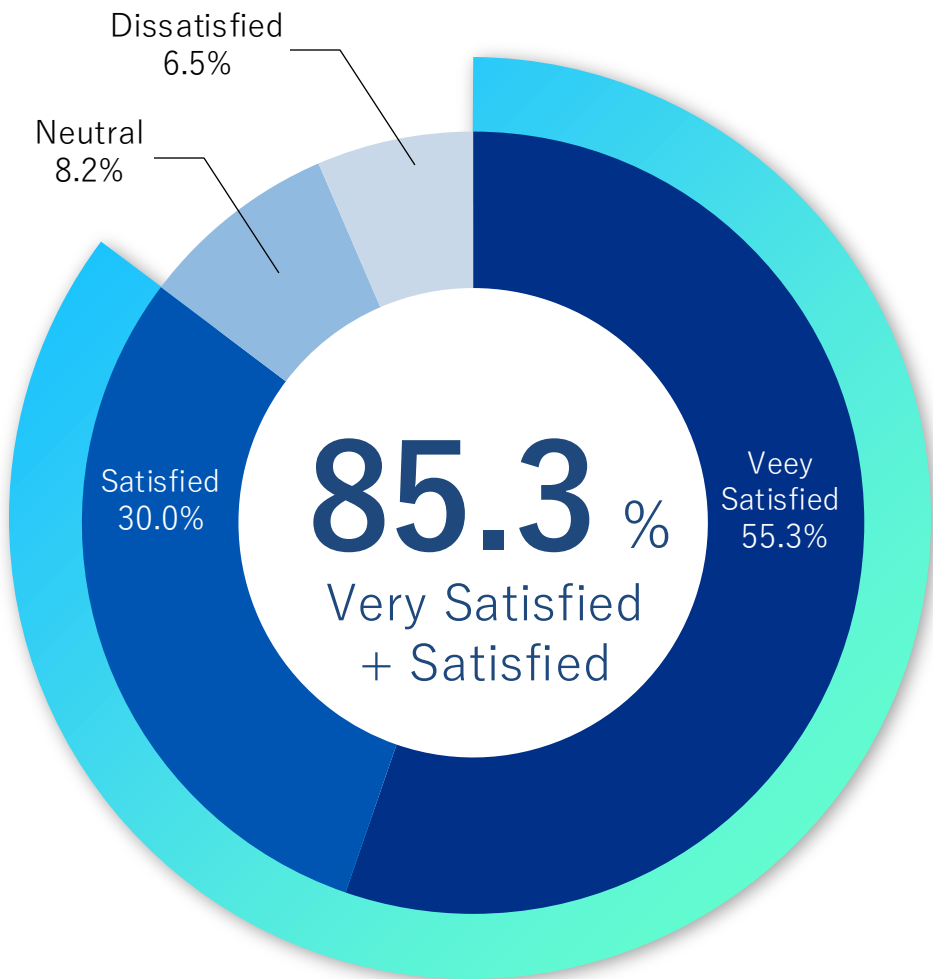

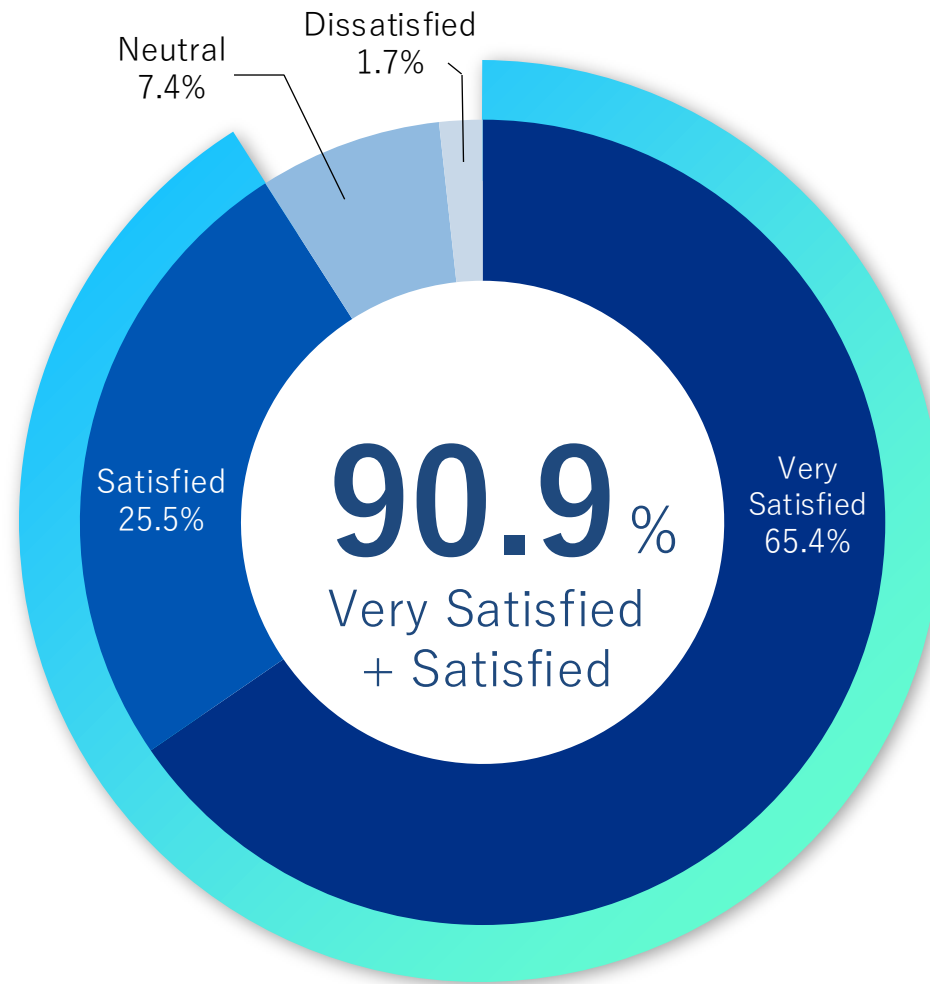
